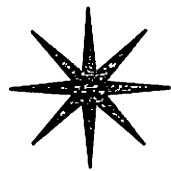

## History of the Alfred Lusk Memorial Scholarship:

The Alfred Lusk Memorial Scholarship was established in the memory of Alfred Lusk, a 1981 graduate of Oceana High School. While a student at OHS, Alfred played football and ran track. After high school, he began working at Mingo Coal Company where he excelled at his work eventually becoming a mine foreman.

Alfred had a very strong work ethic. He was an excellent provider for his family and he always stressed the importance of an education and being the best person you could be. He lived life to the fullest and loved to the fullest.

Alfred was an avid outdoors man and passed this onto his pride and joy, his son Kyle. Kyle was a 2007 graduate of Westside High School. Alfred passed in an accidental drowning in 1999 while fishing with his son, something he loved to do.

Alfred was known to many as kind, generous, and dedicated to his loved ones. In establishing this scholarship, Alfred's family wishes to recognize his dedication to hard work and education. His family is honoring one Westside High School student with a one-time scholarship of \$1,000.00 (\$500.00 per semester).

## Eligibility:

Applicants must meet the requirements listed below to apply for The Alfred Lusk Memorial Scholarship:

- ◆ High school seniors who plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited college or university, two year community, or technical/trade school.
- ◆ Students must major in courses leading to a college degree
- ◆ 3.0 minimum cumulative grade point average

## Awards:

The one time amount of this scholarship is \$500.00. The winner will be announced at Senior Awards Night on Wednesday, June 3, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

*APPLICANTS MUST BE PRESENT AT THEIR SENIOR AWARDS NIGHT TO RECEIVE THIS SCHOLARSHIP. IF THE STUDENT IS NOT PRESENT THAT NIGHT, THE COMMITTEE WILL THEN CONTACT THEIR ALTERNATE CHOICE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP TO BE GIVEN TO THAT APPLICANT.*

## Application:

Interested students must complete the attached application and return it with a current, complete official transcript to Mrs. Stewart, Westside High School counselor, no later than 2:30 p.m. April 30, 2019. Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied. Therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. All information received is considered confidential.

## Selection of Recipients:

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, demonstrated leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, statement of goals and aspirations, and unusual personal or family circumstance.

## Revisions:

The Alfred Lusk Memorial Scholarship committee reserves the right to review the conditions and procedures of this scholarship program and to make changes at any time including termination of the program.

Limit each essay to 200-300 word. Attach both essays to this application. Include your name and title on each page that you attach.

GOALS AND ASPIRATIONS:

Please write the committee a paragraph about yourself that shows you are deserving for the scholarship.

ESSAY:

Please describe a person in your life such as a teacher, coach, minister, parent, friend, etc. that has guided or influenced your life in anyway.

APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

The student is responsible for submitting all materials to Mrs. Stewart, School Counselor, on or before April 30, 2020. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. The application becomes complete and valid only when all of the following materials have been received:

- Student Application With All Blanks Completed
- Applicant has a 3.0 grade point average
- Current Complete Transcript of Grades
- Copy of college acceptance letter that you plan on attending
- Letter of recommendation. Letter should be written on letterhead. Include the recommendation with all other application materials as part of your application packet. Remember, your parents, immediate family members, school counselors, and school administrators are NOT eligible to write the letter of recommendation. You may consider a recommendation from the following: teacher, coach, employer, or minister.

CERTIFICATION:

I acknowledge decisions are final. I certify I meet eligibility requirements of the program as described in the guidelines, and the information provided is complete and accurate to the best of my knowledge. If requested, I will provide proof of information. Falsification of information may result in termination of any award granted.
