

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Scholarship Program General Information

Am I eligible to apply?

This scholarship fund has specific eligibility criteria that were defined by the E-Z Stop committee.

Criteria that apply are as follows:

- The recipient must be a Wyoming East or Westside High School senior.
- The recipient must demonstrate academic achievement and minimum 3.0 cumulative high school GPA.
- The recipient must be accepted by an accredited college or university leading to a four-year degree
- Has demonstrated strength of character, desire for success, willingness to work hard and achieve one's goals, and the likelihood of completing the requirements of a college degree

What is the deadline to apply?

Application materials must be returned to your school's senior counselor, by 2:30 pm, May 4, 2020. All application materials must be returned as a single packet. No application will be considered after this date.

When will I found out if I have been awarded the scholarship:

Applicants will be announced at the Senior Awards Ceremony on Wednesday, June 3, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

If I am awarded this scholarship, how much will I receive?

The one-time scholarship amount is \$1,000.

Is this a need-based scholarship?

Not completely. However, all students who apply for this scholarship must include information regarding all other scholarships, federal money and outside resources. This will be taken into consideration when choosing a recipient.

Application Guidelines:

<u>Deadline:</u> Applications must be received by the Counseling Department by 2:30 P.M., May 4, 2020. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS!

The following information should be included in order to be considered a <u>complete application</u> <u>packet</u>:

- 1) Application Form
- 2) Leadership and Activities Form
- 3) Grade Certification Form
- 4) Two Letters of Recommendation

- 5) Copy of College Acceptance Letter
- 6) Personal Statement Essay
- 7) Official High School Transcript

<u>Letters of Recommendation-</u> When selecting someone to complete your recommendation, select someone who will be thorough in his or her review of your character. Select two non-family member who knows you (and your family) well and will be able to give a candid and unbiased evaluation. Your recommendation must be completed by someone other than your parents, immediate family, or school counselors. You may consider securing a recommendation from two of the following: teacher, minister, coach, or employer.

<u>Personal Statement of Goals and Aspirations</u>- Take time to prepare a typed, well-written, grammatically correct personal statement. While GPA, ACT/SAT scores, financial need, etc. are important selection criteria, a strong personal essay often sets one student apart from others. Let us know something about you that we may not learn from the rest of your application.

<u>Unusual Circumstances</u> - If applicable explain any unusual or personal circumstances that may have affected your achievement in school, work experience, or your participation in school and community activities.

<u>Official Transcript-</u> As a high school student, you must provide a transcript that includes grades from your 9th grade year through January of your 12th grade year.

Application Checklist

- Application Guidelines- Carefully read this page to ensure your application form and all other forms are complete and accurate.
- Leadership and Activities Form- Do not attach a resume or additional pages; use only the page included in this packet.
- □ Personal Statement Form: Include a written, typed statement detailing your goals and aspirations for your educational and long term goals.
- a **Letters of Recommendation-** Include two recommendations with all of the other application materials. Remember, parents, immediate family members or school counselors are **NOT** eligible to write these letters of recommendation.
- □ **Grade Certification Form-** Have your School Counselor complete the form and return it with the other application materials.
- □ Official Transcript- Request transcripts that include grades from the most recently completed semester (January 2020) and send it along with the other application materials. This transcript must be stamped with the official high school seal.
